Paul and Patsy are not happy.
Their 18-year-old son, Pete,
was pulled over by police on his way
home from a prom party and charged
with Driving Under the Influence (DUI).
His Blood Alcohol Content (BAC) was .04.

What is Pete's fate?

Pennsylvania has a
Zero Tolerance Law
for those under 21 who
drive with any measurable
amount of alcohol in their blood.

The law reduced the BAC
from .08 to **.02** for underage
drinkers charged with DUI.

Pete's BAC was over the .02 limit
and, if convicted of DUI, he faces:

- 12 to 18 month license suspension
- 48 hours to 6 months jail time
- Fines from \$500 to \$5,000
