

Play It Safe *with* Paul and Patsy PennDOT



With years of driving experience between them, Paul and Patsy know the proper procedures for coming to a complete stop at intersections with a stop sign.

Do you know where to stop?

When approaching an intersection with a stop sign, a driver must come to a complete stop before the following markings on the road:

- A stop line;
- A crosswalk;
- If no markings, before entering the intersection.

If you cannot see, pull forward cautiously until you can see oncoming traffic clearly, stop, make sure the intersection is clear and proceed with caution.

Remember: You may not proceed if there are people in a crosswalk, vehicles in the intersection, or vehicles close enough to constitute a hazard.
